Week #1 Cactus Classic Desert Tour \$995

Arrive in Tucson (fly in), Saturday, February 20
68-89 miles per day to Wickenburg and back
Depart from Tucson (fly out), Saturday, February 27

Week #2 Coaching Week \$1,095

Arrive in Tucson (fly in), Saturday, February 27
Based in Sierra Vista 50-82 miles per day
Depart from Tucson (fly out), Saturday, March 6

Week #3 Tour of the Historic Hotels \$1,295

Arrive in Tucson (fly in), Saturday, March 6
50 miles per day between classic Arizona hotels
Depart from Tucson (fly out), Saturday, March 13

Week #4 Chiricahua Challenge \$1,095

Arrive in Tucson (fly in), Saturday, March 13
75-90 miles per day to the Chiricahua Mountains
Depart from Tucson (fly out), Saturday, March 20

Week #5 Century Week \$1,095

Arrive in Tucson (fly in), Saturday, March 20
Based in Sierra Vista 60-100 miles per day
Depart from Tucson (fly out), Saturday, March 27

New Elite Transcontinental

San Diego, CA to Williamsburg, VA

Arrive in San Diego Saturday, May 15 \$3,395

19 days 3,200 miles 168 miles per day

8 days 175-200 miles per day

Fly home Friday, June 4th

This tour is only for Elite Riders! Each day is planned to offer the best support and efficiency for riders who want to simulate riding at a Race Across America pace across the country during daylight hours. RAAM winners Lon Haldeman and Susan Notorangelo will help you mentally and physically to succeed during this difficult tour. A recommended training goal is to ride 300 kilometers in 10 hours or complete 350 miles in 24 hours. Our route will follow 75% of the RAAM 2010 route with a good mix of mountains and back roads. Riders who complete 100% of the tour (14 mph minimum elapsed time) will qualify for the Race Across America.

Wisconsin Tour

Start and finish in Beloit, Wisconsin \$1,095

Arrive Saturday, June 19, fly home Saturday June 26

80-90 hilly miles per day

Mile per mile southwestern Wisconsin has some of the best cycling conditions in the country including the famous Elroy-Sparta Railroad tunnel trail. Hundreds of miles of rural roads meander through valleys and over bluffs of this farming region. This Wisconsin Tour travels to different towns and hotels each night. Some lunches are at small town cafes. This is a fun tour suitable for intermediate to advanced riders. This tour is intended for riders who can travel 50 miles in four hours on hilly terrain.

New Redesigned Northern Transcontinental

Everett, Washington to Williamsburg, Virginia

Arrive in Everett, WA Saturday, July 10 \$4,395

30 riding days 3,484 miles 116 miles per day

Fly home Tuesday, August 10

This tour offers 1,000 miles of new roads with more constant daily distances. Our new route stays near Grand Coulee Dam before heading to Spokane, WA and Idaho. We cross the Continental Divide in Montana and then climb the steep Big Horn Mountains in Wyoming. We spend an extra night in the Black Hills near Mount Rushmore, South Dakota. Each day offers changing terrain with a new route across Iowa, Illinois and Indiana. The eastern states have many challenging climbs through very scenic Ohio and West Virginia before finishing in Historic Williamsburg, Virginia.

Grand Canyon Tour (hike and bike)

Arrive in Albuquerque, New Mexico Sat. Sept. 18

Fly home from Albuquerque on Sun. Oct. 3 \$2,195

11 cycling days (85-110 miles per day) 3 hiking days

This tour has a fun mix with over 1,100 miles of cycling and three hiking days in the Grand Canyon and Canyon de Chelly. Voted by PAC Tour veterans as one of our best tours in the beautiful southwest.

The Elite, Northern and Canyon Tour prices are for groups of 30 or more paid riders. There is a \$300 surcharge for groups of less than 30 paid riders.
